

How to Play Trash Towkay

Setting Up the Game

1. Remove all *Event Cards* from the deck and shuffle the rest of the deck.
2. Hand out 5 cards from the deck, and 3 tokens, to each player.
3. Shuffle the *Event Cards* back into the remaining deck.
4. Pick the player who recycles the most to start first (or use a die to determine the starter, where the highest roll goes first), and the play proceeds clockwise.

Playing the Game

1. Each player starts his turn by drawing 1 card from the deck.
 - Note that if an *Event Card* is drawn, the player must place the *Event Card* face up and then draw another card from the deck.
 - All players can then carry out the action stated on the *Event Card*. If multiple *Event Cards* are drawn one after another, the players can only carry out the actions stated on the *Event Cards* sequentially, starting from the latest drawn *Event Card*.
 - Once the action stated on an *Event Card* has been carried out, the player places the card in the discard pile.
2. The player can then take as many of the following actions during his turn:
 - Use one token to draw another card from the deck.
 - Place completed sets of *Item Cards* facing up.
 - Note that each category of *Item Cards* has its own requirement for completing a set (e.g. a *Trash* set requires 3 *Trash Cards* and a token, while a *Bulky Item Card* counts as a set by itself but can only be placed if the *Town Council Event Card* is facing up).
 - Play the *Action Cards* in his hand (e.g. gain tokens, swap a card with another player).
 - *Action Cards* that have been played, must be placed in the discard pile.
3. The first player who completes 3 unique sets of *Item Cards* wins the game!
