Easy as One, Tree,

Here're ways you can help:

Move the tree/branch aside if it is safe to do so

Your small act benefits other road or footpath users including seniors and those with mobility issues.



Call the 24-hour NParks helpline at 1800-471-7300 if the tree/branch is too big

The tree/branch may cause an obstruction such as blocking the road or footpath if left untouched. With your report, we will activate our contractors to clear the tree/branch.



Did you know?

Why do branches fall off?

Rainy and windy weather may cause healthy branches to snap and fall off. This is due to weather conditions rather than poor health or tree decay.

Who maintains the trees in Singapore?

Various agencies maintain the trees in Singapore. NParks conducts tree inspections along major roads with heavy human/ vehicular activity at least once a year.

How about privately owned trees?

Private property owners are responsible for the maintenance or removal of fallen trees/branches within their premises.
